## **Start Online I-765 application**

These instructions are for students seeking to submit an I-765 draft for ISS to review when requesting an OPT I-20. Please remember: DO NOT submit your I-765 application to USCIS before receiving your OPT I-20 from UW ISS.

- 1. Create an account with USCIS. See their tutorial.
- 2. Click 'File a Form Online'



3. Choose I-765, Application for Employment Authorization. Read and review the information in the next screens and click Next

Use this form to request employment authorization and an Employment Authorization Document (EAD) if your immigration status allows you to work in the United States.

A Note: You may submit Form I-765 online only if your eligibility category is:

- (c)(3)(A) F-1 student, pre-completion OPT;
- (c)(3)(B) F-1 student, post-completion OPT;
- · (c)(3)(C) F-1 student, 24-month extension for STEM students (students
